

Las Animas County, founded in 1866, is the largest county by area in Colorado with a total of 4,775 square miles. It sits along the Mountain Branch of the Santa Fe Trail and served as the major city in southeast Colorado until the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad established operations in La Junta, 20 miles to the west of Las Animas. It shares a boundary with northern New Mexico. If you are interested in serving with us, please sign-up and pay your deposit online.
