Music Notes

From Heaven Above to Earth I Come (in German, Von Himmel hoch, da komm ich her) is a Christmas hymn written in 1534 by Martin Luther. From its 17 verses, here are a selected few:

- 1. From heaven above to earth I come to bear good news to every home; Glad tidings of great joy I bring whereof I now will say and sing:
- 2. To you this night is born a child of Mary, chosen mother mild; This little child, of lowly birth, shall be the joy of all your earth.
- 17. Glory to God in highest heaven, who unto man His Son hath given! While angels sing with pious mirth a glad New Year to all the earth.

This old Lutheran hymn has inspired many organ settings including those by Pachelbel (1693) and Walther (after 1700) shared today.
