Music Notes: Service music this Advent, Christmas, and Epiphany come from Trio West and their albums *Trio West Holiday* (2007) and *Trio West Holiday, Vol. 2* (2009). Trio West is a New York City based jazz trio formed by composer/drummer Tobias Gebb. All the members of the band have lived or currently live on the west side of Manhattan - thus the band name. Collectively, the members have played with a laundry list of top jazz (and other) performers including Cab Calloway, Peter Burnstein, John Hendricks, Larry Goldings, Ben Monder, Frank Wess, Etta Jones, and many others. Members and guests have included Eldad Zvulun, Neal Miner, Champian Fulton, Joel Frahm, Bobby Watson, Ron Blake, and others. The band has been playing around the New York tristate area since 2005. Their music is characterized by a chill, laid back jazz sound that pulls from different styles (trad, modern, latin, Brazilian, free) and may be similar to artists like Ahmad Jamal, Herbie Hancock and Ramsey Lewis. *O Tannenbaum* is a 16th century folk tune with lyrics written in German in 1824 by Ernst Anschutz. The song alludes to God's steady faithfulness and joyful constancy through time by praising the evergreen fir trees we bring into our homes at Christmas. It has been translated from the German:


