The ShelbyNext Portal will be used exclusively by church members who have a valid email address that matches the one in our database. <u>Rest assured that your personal data is secure</u>. The only information that is shared between members is your immediate contact information (ie. Name, Email, Phone Number) and you can set restrictions on what you would like viewed as well. The roll out of the new church directory app powered by ShelbyNext provides our congregation with a tool to effectively connect with one another while connecting, as a community, with God and the mission and ministries He has called us to take part in.
