WHAT IS A JESSE TREE?



Jesse Tree is an Advent tradition named after Jesse, the father of King David. Biblical symbols representing the ancestry of Jesus, either in faith or bloodline, are added one by one to a tree. As each ornament is added, a Bible story is read to explain the symbol. There is one ornament for each day beginning December 1 and ending Christmas day.

Fairhope United Methodist Church GUIDELINES FOR OUR 2019 JESSE TREE ORNAMENT SWAP

- (1) SIGN UP Online registration opens Sunday, October 27 at www.fairhopeumc.org. Click on Ministries/Children/Jesse Tree. All 25 symbols must be signed up for in order to hold the ornament swap.
 - Yes, you may sign up for more than one symbol. For each symbol you choose, you will receive one complete set of ornaments. Spread the word to your family and friends and have them signup, too!
- (2) **DESIGN** After you've signed up for a symbol, design your ornament. <u>Suggestion</u>: Google Jesse Tree and you will find lots of websites and images or simply go to Pinterest to get great ideas! You do not have to reinvent the wheel! It will be helpful to read the corresponding scripture that goes with your symbol.
- (3) WAIT Don't buy materials to make your ornaments until you've received an email that all symbols have been taken. We can only do this swap if we have someone for each symbol. The deadline to signup is Friday, November 8. Hopefully, it won't take that long to fill.
- (4) MAKE Once you've received the green light email, you will make <u>26</u> ornaments of the symbol you chose (the same ornament <u>26</u> times ~ 25 for the swap and one for the church). Ornaments need to be 4 inches or smaller. Please consider that large, heavy ornaments may be difficult to hang on some trees. All ornaments should include a hook or loop or some way to be hung. When choosing materials, please consider that these ornaments are to last for years to come.
- (5) **DELIVER** Everyone MUST bring their ornaments to the church office <u>no later than</u> 2:00pm on Friday, November 15. Please have each individual ornament placed in a clear re-sealable plastic <u>sandwich</u> bag. Place your 26 bags in a larger bag or box and make sure your name and symbol are written on the outside.
- (6) PICK UP You may pick up your complete set of Jesse Tree ornaments from the church office on Sunday, November 24 (8:00am ~ 12:00pm) or Monday, November 25 (8:00am ~ 4:00pm). Bags will be in the office with participant names on them. Find your bag and get ready for a great Advent experience. (Each ornament will have a label on the plastic bag with the date it is to be hung, symbol, related Bible story and who made the ornament.) The first ornament will be hung on Sunday, December 1.
 - There will also be a booklet with the day-by-day scripture reading and a prayer.
