### The Response: Baldwin Family Village, a Transitional Housing Program

- Turn key facility located at: 19570 County Road 33, Fairhope, Alabama 36532
- Plan to serve 100 homeless single women and women with children annually
- Baldwin Family Village will be operated as a program of the Dumas Wesley Community Center

### Dumas Wesley Community Center

- Founded in Mobile, Alabama in 1903 by the United Methodist Women
- Provides over a dozen programs and services for homeless families, senior citizens, at-risk youth, and the working poor
- Dumas Wesley Community Center's Transitional Housing Program, Sybil H. Smith Family Village has an 88% success rate among residents moving into permanent housing - 24% higher than the national average
