#### AT-RISK INDIVIDUALS

All individuals that are within the high-risk groups and anyone feeling sick, we encourage you to stay at home and continue to worship with us virtually.

### NURSERY, CHILDREN'S CHURCH & SUNDAY SCHOOL

Nursery and Children's Church will not be provided at this time. Children will be seated with their parents/guardians for the whole service. Adult Sunday School classes and small groups that have been meeting virtually will continue to do so at this time.

## **ONCE YOU ARRIVE:**



#### FACE MASKS

A face covering can slow the spread of the virus and help prevent people from unknowingly transmitting it to others. Facemasks are expected for adults and children 2nd grade and older. Masks will be available if you do not have one.



#### **DAILY SELF-ASSESSMENT**

All staff members and volunteers will have their temperatures taken upon arrival.



#### HAND SANITIZING STATIONS

Hand sanitizing stations are located at all entrances to our buildings and sanctuary as well as throughout our campus. Remember to wash your hands frequently and use hand sanitizer between washings to eliminate germs.



#### **PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING**

We will be seating you in chairs (CLC) and pews (sanctuary) and will maintain at least 6 feet between family units. Dismissal will be done by sections. At this time we ask that you do not congregate before or after worship services.



To maintain the 6 foot distance requirement by the CDC and Alabama Public Health Dept, we are limiting the indoor seating capacity for each service. Reservations will be taken online each Sunday at 4pm. Online worship will still be offered through Facebook, YouTube & <u>www.fairhopeumc.org</u>



#### SANITATION
