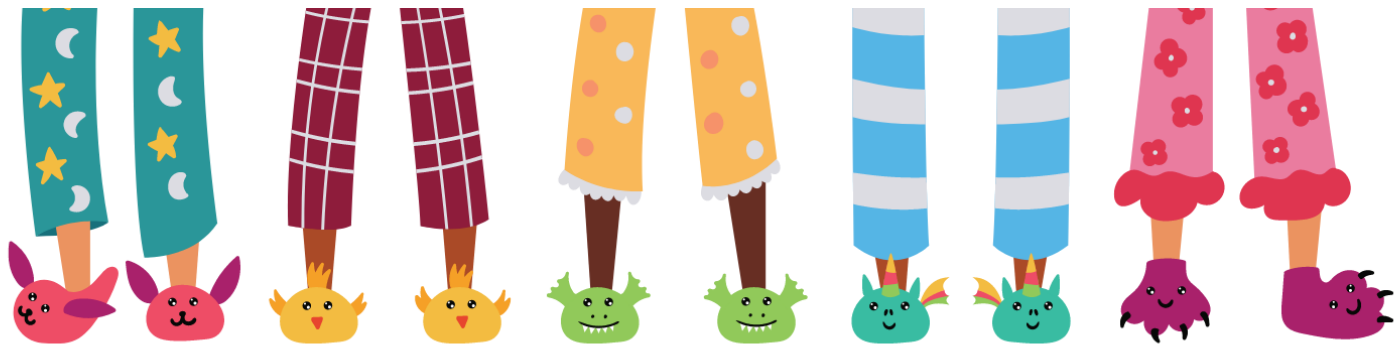

Important Information

All participants, whether VBS, Pajama Party Wednesdays or other activities, must have a notarized 2022-2023 Emergency Release on file.

EXPECTATIONS OF CHILDREN:

- * Be respectful to leaders and to each other.
- * Listen and obey.
- * Be honest.
- * Walk in the Spirit! (Are you showing: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, & -the hardest SELF CONTROL?)

We love having fun, but we also want our kids to be safe. To make sure everyone has a great time, **below is our behavior policy:**

1. A child will get 3 warnings, then will be removed from the activity for a short period of time.
2. If issues persist, parents will be contacted and asked to work together with our KidMin team to avoid future situations.
3. If there is an instance of a physical nature (biting, hitting, etc.), child will be immediately removed from activity for a period of time. Parents of children involved will be notified.

If your child has any exceptional need, please let us know when arriving or signing up. This helps us greatly to minister to our kids and handle any situation properly.

2022-2023 Children's Ministries Emergency Release

In this regard, it is understood that any medical, hospital and/or surgical expenses which may be incurred as a result of treatment recommended by any such doctor will be borne by me/us. Further, I/we affirm that all information on this form is current and accurate.
